Dear Sir.

First of all allow me to congratulate you on the attainment of your Diamond Jubilee, particularly as it is associated with our old student G. C. Bose, whose name is on our Dining Hall wall and which I cannot fail to see everytime I have a meal there. He was an outstanding student. I have scrutinised his Examination Results and find that in his first year he got more marks than any one else, in fact he got 2,990, and the next man, J. H. Dugdale, got 2.918. He was top in Agriculture, Chemistry, Law, Veterinary Science and Botany. In his final year he was second in his Examinations, Dugdale getting 1599 marks and Bose 1532. He had highest marks in Agriculture and Chemistry. Dugdale you will be interested to know was the first County Organiser of Agricultural Education in this Country. During the period Mr. Bose was a student here the Principal was the Revd. J. B. McClellan, M.A., and about 100 students were in residence. They were mostly the Sons of land owners and large farmers.

The Professor of Agriculture during that time was Professor Wallace, whose book on ''British Breeds of Livestock'' is well known. He later became Professor of Agriculture in Edinburgh. You will also be interested to know that Professor Warrington, of here and later Rothamsted, was his Examiner in Chemistry. Over-lapping with him, but not in the same years, was Mr. L. G. Sutton of the famous seed firm at Reading.

I am enclosing a copy of the College Prospectus in which you will find photographs of the college.

In addition I enclose a list of students now on our Register.

The Governors, Staff, Students and myself wish you great progress and much success.




Royal Agricultural College, Circnester, England, where the Founder was a student during 1881-1883




The Dining Hall in the Royal Agricultural College, Circnester, where the name of the Founder is inscribed in the wall

118 Bowbazar Street, Calcutta, where the School and the College shifted in 1889




191 Bowbazar Street, Calcutta, where the College shifted in 1896








Bangabasi College Mess at 72/A Akhil Mistri Lane, Calcutta




