- (5) Puja Social was held on 25-9-38 with an eminent journalist Mr. Satyendra Nath Majumder the editor of Ananda Bazar Patrika as chairman of the function. It was a very pleasant function, and there was a record gathering. Prominent artists of Bengal were seen on the stage. We organised a cultural conference along with

the Social. Prof. Surendra Goswami, Benoy Banerjee were Presidents of different sections of the conference.

(6) This year we helped nearly one hundred students with stipends every month.

(7) We contributed Rs. 50 for the Flood Relief Fund.
