IN MEMORIAM

The Late Prof. Dakshinaranjan Banerjee

It is with melancholy regret that we have to record here the sudden and quite premature death of Prof. Dakshinaranjan Banerjee, M. Sc., Senior Professor of Botany of this College and General Superintendent of the College Hostel.

During the last Summer Vacation Dakshina Babu was attacked with Typhoid and succumbed to it inspite of the best medical aid. He was a highly capable teacher. His affable manners, his generous nature, and his genial personality made him popular alike with his colleagues and students. He served the college most faithfully for over sixteen years and died in harness. He had always the welfare of this Institution at heart, and the like of him it will not be easy for the college to find. His memory will for ever be enshrined in the hearts of those who ever came in touch with him.

We offer our heart-felt condolence to his widow and the bereaved family. May his soul rest in peace!

As a mark of respect for his memory the college remained closed for two days. His portrait (made out of the contributions of his colleagues) was unveiled by the Principal in the Professors' Room on Monday, the 12th January, 1931, in the presence of the staff. Prof. Mukundalal Chakravarti has promised a silver medal in his memory to to be awarded every year to the best student of Botany among the successful candidates from our college at the Intermediate Examination.
